# HAWTHORN BLUFF CAMPGROUND REGULATIONS

## OOLOGAH, OK

1. **PARK GATE**: Opens 6:00 a.m., closes 10:00 p.m.
2. **QUIET HOURS**: 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
3. **UNITS PER SITE**: One RV & 2 tents or 3 tents per site. Maximum occupants are 10 overnight per site. Maximum vehicles are 3 overnight per site.
4. **SPEED LIMIT**: The speed limit in the park is ten (10) mph. For the safety of everyone in the park, please adhere to this speed limit at ALL times. Observe ONE-WAY signs in park.
5. **LENGTH OF STAY**: Camping at one or more campsites at any one water resource for a period longer than 14 days during any 30-consecutive-day period is prohibited.
6. **VEHICLES**: All vehicles must be “street legal with tags” and must stay on established roads. Golf carts, ATV’s and motorized scooters are not allowed. No battery operated toy vehicles at any time.
7. **ANIMALS**: All pets must be restrained by a leash less than 6’ in length. **Animals are prohibited on designated swim beaches.** You must clean up after your animal.
8. **REFUSE COLLECTIONS**: Bagged trash will not be collected at campsites. Take all trash to the dumpsters located by each restroom and at the nature trail entrance.
9. **FIRE RINGS**: Fire rings are for fires only and are not to be moved for any reason. They are not to be used as trash bins. **No cans, bottles, glass or metal of any type are allowed in fire rings.** Fires should always be attended and extinguished before leaving the campground.
10. **WATER**: Fill your holding tanks. **Hoses are not to be left hooked to hydrants.** No splitters are allowed.
11. **America the Beautiful (ATB) Passes**: Discounts apply only to the cardholder. The cardholder must occupy the site to receive discount. Fraudulent use of the card could result in the card being revoked.

**FAILURE TO ADHERE TO PARK REGULATIONS MAY RESULT IN A FINE.**
