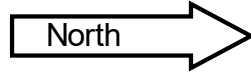

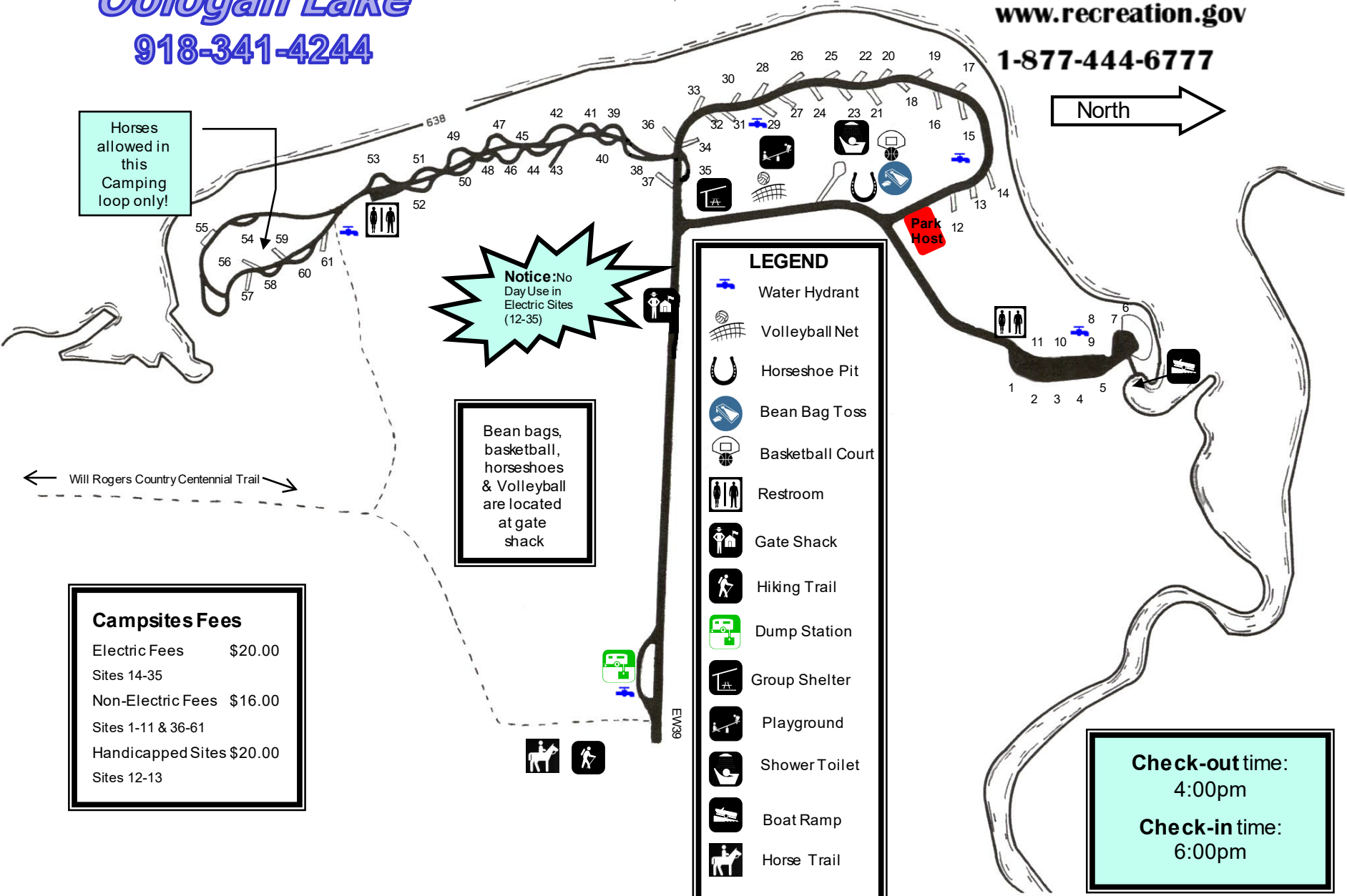

# BLUE CREEK CAMPGROUND REGULATIONS

## OOLOGAH, OK

1. PARK GATE: Opens 6:00 a.m., closes 10:00 p.m.
2. QUIET HOURS: 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
3. UNITS PER SITE: One RV & 2 tents or 3 tents per site. Maximum occupants are 10 overnight per site. Maximum vehicles are 3 overnight per site.
4. SPEED LIMIT: The speed limit in the park is ten (10) mph. For the safety of everyone in the park, please adhere to this speed limit at ALL times. Observe ONE-WAY signs in park.
5. America the Beautiful (ATB) Passes: Discounts apply only to the cardholder. The cardholder must occupy the site to receive discount. Fraudulent use of the card could result in the card being revoked
6. LENGTH OF STAY: No camping unit will be allowed to stay longer than 14 consecutive days on one site during the peak season (May 1 - September 30).
7. VEHICLES: All vehicles must be “street legal with tags” and must stay on established roads. Golf carts, ATV’s and motorized scooters are not allowed. No battery operated toy vehicles at any time.
8. ANIMALS: All pets must be restrained by a leash less than 6’ in length.
9. REFUSE COLLECTIONS: Bagged trash will not be collected at campsites. Take all trash to the dumpsters located within the park.
10. FIRE RINGS: Fire rings are for fires only and are not to be moved for any reason. They are not to be used as trash bins. **No cans, bottles, glass or metal of any type are allowed in fire rings.** Fires should always be attended and extinguished before leaving the campground.
11. WATER: Fill your holding tanks. **Hoses are not to be left hooked to hydrants.** No splitters are allowed.
