



2022 Season Hurricane Campground

LOCATION and DIRECTIONS: Hurricane Campground is located at 2021 Hurricane Camp Rd, Sugar Grove, VA, 15 miles from the town of Marion. From I-81 at Marion take exit 45 onto Hwy 16 South. Continue on Hwy 16 for 15 miles to SR 650 (5 miles South of Sugar Grove). Turn right on SR 650 continue for 2 miles, then turn left onto the paved campground entrance road.

FACILITIES AVAILABLE: There are 24 single units and 2 double units. Some units are reservable at www.recreation.gov or 877-444-6777; the remaining units are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Most units have a paved parking spur, graveled tent pad, picnic table, lantern post, and fire grill. Recreation vehicles up to 22 feet can be accommodated in some units. Water hydrants and a garbage bin are centrally located. Two bathhouses with toilets, warm showers, sinks, and drinking water are provided. A trailer waste disposal station is located at Raccoon Branch Campground 5 miles away.

FEES: Single sites: \$20 per unit, per night (limit of 8 people and 2 vehicles per unit). Double sites: 14d & 15d are \$40 per unit, per night (limit of 16 people and 4 vehicles).

ATTRACTIONS: Hurricane and Comers creeks run through the campground and surrounding areas for wading and trout fishing. Additional fishing options and excellent hunting opportunities are available near the campground. State fishing and hunting regulations and licensing requirements apply. Hurricane Knob Nature Trail offers a brisk 1-mile loop hike and there is easy access to the Appalachian Trail within ½ mile. The entire campground has a relaxing, rustic atmosphere and an open field allows for games and family fun.

CLIMATE and VEGETATION: The elevation of this campground is approximately 2,800 feet. Summer days typically reach temperatures in the 70's to 80's (rarely into the 90's) and evenings cool down to the 50's or 60's. Hurricane is built under a canopy of pines, hemlocks, and hardwoods.

SEASON and PATTERN OF USE: The campground is open from mid-April thru late-October. Weekend use is very popular and weekday camping is moderate. The campground typically fills to capacity during summer holidays and peak-color weekends in the fall. Reservations are recommended at Hurricane Campground throughout the season.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES: The Forest Service welcomes responsible volunteers to serve as hosts in our campgrounds and maintenance of nearby trails. Camping fees are waived for the volunteer host. For more information about volunteering please visit www.volunteer.gov or call 1-800-628-7202.
