

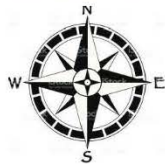

THIS INFORMATION IS TO ENABLE ALL CAMPERS TO HAVE A GOOD STAY AT TALL CHIEF

1. **Water Use:** Individual water hookups are not available. Water facilities may be used to fill holding tanks provided the hose is disconnected when filling is completed. All gray water must be contained.
2. **Quiet Hours:** Quiet hours are from 10:00pm to 6:00am. Radios, generators, or other noise producing equipment may not be operated during these hours. In order to keep vehicle traffic to a minimum, the gates are closed during these hours. All guests not remaining overnight must leave by 9:00pm. Campers should return to Tall Chief Cove before 10PM. Exceptions may be made for emergencies only.
3. **Camping Capacity:** Each site is allowed one camper and up to 3 tents, or a total of 4 tents. Max number of people is 15. Boat trailers may be parked on grass, **NOT VEHICLES**. Max vehicles overnight shall not exceed 4.
4. **Emergencies:** If medical emergency dial 911. Please inform Gate Attendant or a Park Ranger of situations as they occur.
5. **Picnicking Other Day Use:** Campground facilities are for use by registered campers and their visitors only.
6. **Vehicles:** All state motor laws apply. Off-road traffic is not permitted. Observe speed limit signs. Vehicles shall not impede traffic and cannot be parked in grass. Non-compliant vehicles will have to park elsewhere.
7. **Pets:** Pets must be on a leash at all times and are not allowed at the **beach area**.
8. **Swimming Beach:** Alcohol and glass containers are prohibited at the swim beach area.
9. **Fireplaces and Fire Rings:** These are available at each campsite. Fires are permitted only in these containers. Dead wood may be gathered from the ground, but tree cutting is not permitted. Do not remove any wood from campground.
10. **Trash Bags:** Trash bags are available at the gatehouse. Please dispose of all trash in the dumpsters located at the dump station. Remember to leave your campsite clean so others may enjoy camping in a clean site!
