

BASIC CAMPGROUND RULES

The Corps of Engineers welcomes you to our campgrounds at Berlin Lake. In order to make everyone's stay a pleasurable one, listed here are some of the basic campground rules derived from TITLE 36 CFR (Code of Regulations). - CAMPSITE OCCUPANCY is limited to eight (8) people per campsite including visitors (six years of age or older). Persons camping under eighteen (18) years of age must be accompanied by an adult. Children may not be left unattended in the campground without adult supervision.
- CAMPING EQUIPMENT must be set up on gravel impact area or pavement. Three sleeping units are allowed per site; only one recreational vehicle. In addition, screen tent is allowed.
- VEHICLES ON CAMPSITES are limited to a maximum number of two (2) vehicles per campsite, other than camping equipment. Two tires must be on the gravel of vehicles.
- **CHECK-IN TIME is 3PM.** Campers may check in earlier on day of reservation if site is available.
- **CHECK-OUT TIME** is by **1PM.** Campers and their guests are required to leave the campground at checkout time. An additional night's camping fee may be charged for late departures.
- VISITORS must depart the campground by 10 PM. Visitors are subject to same regulations as registered campers.
- CAMPING LIMIT is 14 consecutive days or 14 non-consecutive days in any 30-day period at all Corps of Engineers-operated campgrounds on the Berlin Lake Project.
- QUIET HOURS are in effect from 10 PM to 6 AM daily. Unreasonably loud noise is prohibited at any time.
- PASSES MUST BE DISPLAYED from rear-view mirror or dash of all vehicles.
- Generators may be operated between the hours of 6 AM to 10PM.
- FIREWORKS, FIREARMS, EXPLOSIVES, and PROJECTILE-FIRING DEVICES are prohibited.
- CAMPFIRES must be confined to fireplaces or grills. Do not leave fires unattended. Extinguish all fires upon departure from campsite. Only dead wood on the ground may be collected for firewood.
- DESIGNATED SWIMMING AREAS are not supervised. Swim at your own risk. Swimming at launching ramps and courtesy docks is prohibited.
- PETS **MAXIMUM THREE (3) PETS PER CAMPSITE** (NO EXCEPTIONS) Wild, exotic, vicious and/or aggressive pet, and livestock are not permitted in the campground. Excessive barking or disturbance by pets is prohibited at all times. All pets must be penned, caged, or restrained on a leash no longer than six (6) feet. Invisible fences or shock collars are not sufficient. Pet owners must dispose of all pet's waste in dumpsters. Pets are not allowed in restrooms, on playgrounds, or on beaches. **DO NOT LEAVE PETS UNATTENDED INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE CAMPER AND/OR TENT.**
- TREES in the park are protected. Hang lanterns on metal hangers at the campsite. Do not nail, saw, or cut trees.
- **ALCOHOL is PROHIBITED.**
- SINKS in restrooms are not to be used for washing pets, dishes, cleaning fish, etc.
- GRAY/WASTE WATER must be caught in holding tank or another receptacle and deposited at the dump station. Washing vehicles, camping equipment, or anything that produces gray water to be discharged on or around the campsite is prohibited.
- FEEDING GEESE AND OTHER WILDLIFE is prohibited due to health and environmental concerns.
- ALL GARBAGE MUST BE PLACED IN THE DUMPSTERS which are located throughout the campground. Do not deposit garbage in fire rings or grills. Campsite must be kept clean during occupancy and cleaned upon departure. Do not leave garbage bag on the site.
- **No golf carts/scooters/mini-bikes, e-bikes, etc. No riding on the exterior of vehicles. No joy riding.**
- Any act or conduct which interferes, impedes, or disrupts another person's use of the project (boisterous, rowdy or disorderly) is prohibited.
- Failure to abide by these park regulations and restrictions may result in legal action, expulsion, and/or forfeiture of fees paid.
- The person registered for a campsite shall be presumed to be responsible for any violation of rules unless proven otherwise.
- Interference with any Park Ranger, government employee, volunteer, or contractor in the conduct of their official duty is prohibited. Individuals may be required to furnish proper identification to Park Rangers.
