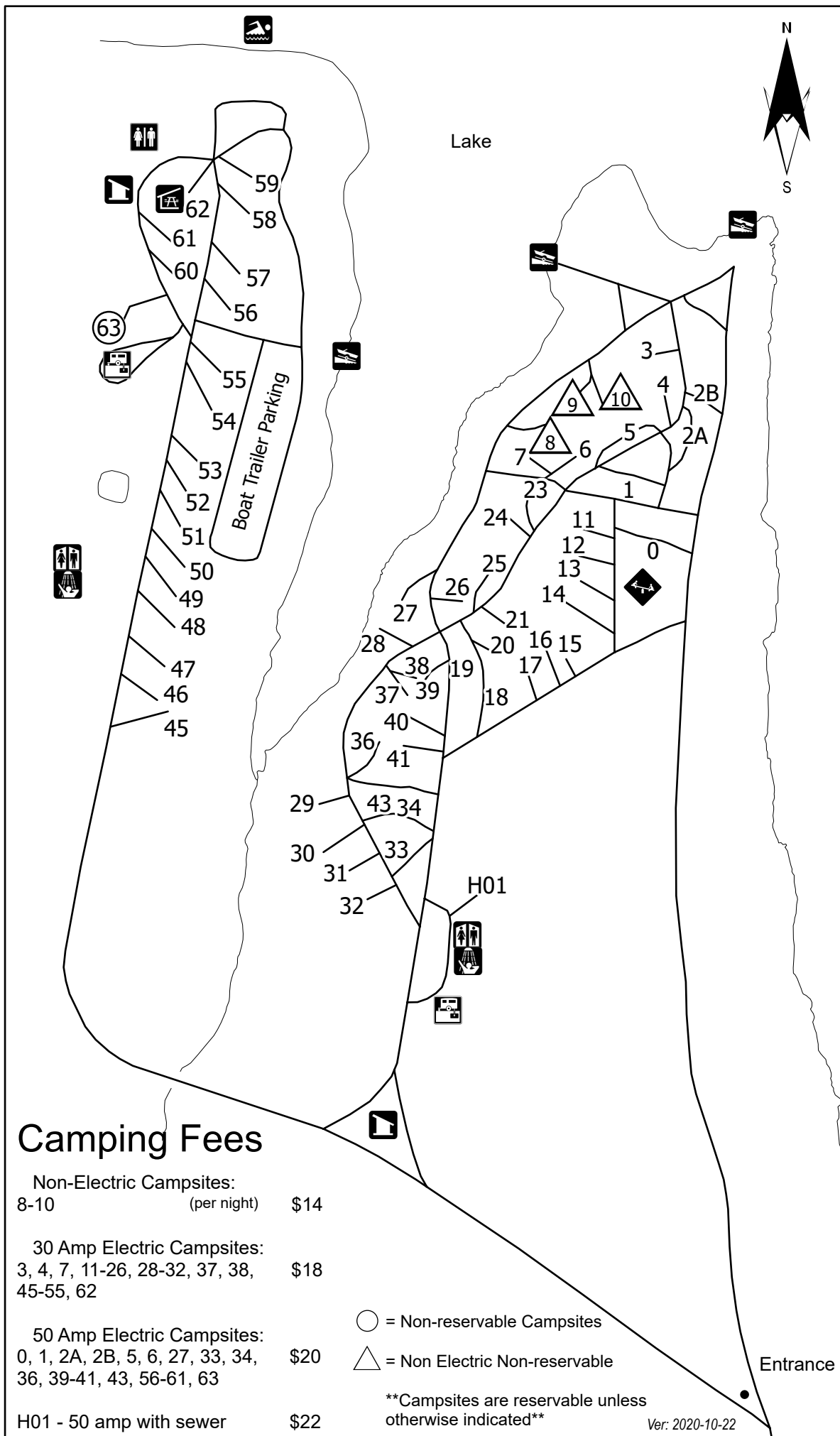

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Rules & Regulations

1. **Park Gates:** Open at 6 am and Close at 10 pm.
2. **Quiet Hours:** 10 pm – 6 am.
3. **Reservations:** Check-In 5 pm, Check-Out 3 pm.
4. **Non-Reserved Camping Sites:** For non-reserved sites, a camping unit (tent, RV) must be on site prior to gate attendants accepting payment. Campsites may not be held (reserved) with passenger vehicles, boat trailers, lawn chairs, etc.
5. **Camping Site 14-day Limit:** No visitor or camping unit will be allowed to stay longer than 14 consecutive days or more than 14 days within a 30 day period.
6. **Site Appearance:** Sites must be kept clean and free from excessive personal property. Limit, one wheeled camping unit per site. The number of additional camping units is based off the occupancy of the site.
7. **Golden Age, Golden Access & America the Beautiful Discount Cards:** Discounts apply only to the cardholder. Cardholder must occupy the site to receive discount.
8. **Vehicles:** All vehicles must be street legal with state legal tags and must stay on established roads. Golf carts, ATVs, motorized scooters, etc. may not be used in the park.
9. **Pets:** All pets must be restrained by a leash not longer than 6 feet. Customers are responsible for ensuring their pets are not loud or otherwise disruptive to other customers. Aggressive or vicious acting pets are prohibited. Do not leave pets alone for extended periods of time.
10. **Trees:** Please help protect our trees. Do not place nails or screws in trees or otherwise damage trees.
11. **Fireworks:** Fireworks may not be discharged or possessed in the park or on other government property.
12. **Refuse Collection:** Please take all trash to the camp dumpsters. This helps reduce our clean-up costs. Please do not place any trash in the fire rings.
13. **Reservations:** Reservations for this park may be made through Recreation One Stop (R1S) at 1-877-444-6777 or online at www.recreation.gov.
