































	For an enjoyable experience, please abide by Title 36 CFR USACE Regulations. Get a copy at the gatehouse or online for a full list of Federal Property Regulations.		Park hours are 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. Park gates are LOCKED at 10 p.m. and OPENED at 6 a.m. No exceptions unless 911 has been called. In the event of an emergency, notify host on duty.		Please see volunteer host at gatehouse BEFORE proceeding to your campsite. Call gatehouse number posted if no one is available at arrival. Notify host on duty if emergency vehicles have been called to the park.
	Campers may check-in at 4 p.m. or earlier if site is prepared & available. Camper must check-out/depart by 3 p.m. Drop hangtag in box (adjacent to gatehouse) upon departure.		Guests visiting registered campers must request a visitor hang tag from the host on duty. Visitors must depart before 10 p.m.		For camping reservations or modifications call 877-444-6777, visit recreation.gov or mobile app
	Registered campers do not have to pay launch fee. Non-registered campers must purchase a Day Use Pass \$5 or Annual Pass \$40. See QR code, host or recreation.gov for more info. America the Beautiful pass displayed waives launch fee.		Fires should be contained in a fire ring/grill. Extinguish before departing. Dead limbs/fallen trees may be utilized for campfires. Firewood can be purchased onsite from Friends of Foscue.		Shelter reservations are non-refundable. Shelters can only be occupied/utilized from 6 a.m. to sunset. The use of confetti, water balloons and water inflatables are prohibited.
	Campers must deposit garbage in dumpster provided. Deposit sewage/gray water using dump station unless campsite has sewage hook-up available.		Obey posted speed limits. We love our guests and wildlife! Golf carts are acceptable under these conditions: 16 yrs. + driver, operating cart in a safe manner and staying on paved roads.		Golden Age/Golden Access, Senior/Access Pass holder is the only person authorized to use pass when reserving a campsite. HOLDER MUST: be in camping party, occupy site overnight & is required to show pass. Pass may not be applied to multiple sites.
	There is a walking/jogging trail available in the park. Enjoy Nature..... LEAVE NO TRACE.		Length of stay is limited to no more than 14 days during a 30-day consecutive period.		Quiet hours are observed between 10 p.m. - 6 a.m. so all have a positive experience at the park.

	While fishing, boating, or kayaking in and around the water, please wear your lifejacket. Expect the Unexpected...Be Prepared!		Absolutely no recreational/illegal drugs of any kind are prohibited on government property.		Please do not dump guts in dumpster or behind campsites. Dispose according to Alabama State Law.
	Inflatable pools, hot tubs or slides utilizing water are not allowed. Water balloons are prohibited on government property.		Due to health and safety concerns, please do not approach, feed, or disturb wildlife. Remember you are visiting in their habitat!		Animals must be kept on a 6-foot leash or small portable pen. No electric fence units. You are responsible for your pet's waste disposal. Be respectful of others, no one wants to step in POOP!
	Vehicles/Boats may not be parked on adjacent campsites unless reserved by you. 8 persons is the maximum number per registered campsite. 3 vehicles allowed per campsite.		Parents, Grandparents, Guardians please do not leave minors unattended. Please be responsible!		No smoking in bathhouse facilities.
	The area in and around the park/campground is designated as a no-swimming area.		The possession of loaded firearms, fireworks, explosives, and/or projectile devices are not allowed on government premises.		Please no animals in showers/bathhouses. Unless otherwise, identified as a service animal.
	Note: All our campsites are spacious and can manage most camping units. However, in loop 35-45, the hairpin loop is tight for turning larger motorhomes and 5th wheels.		Kayaks are available to registered campground guests. Paddles must be checked-out at gatehouse. Lifejacket must be worn, and minors must be accompanied by an adult.		Clothes lines strung across campsites are not allowed.
	The posting of partisan political signage/flying of flags is not allowed on government property.		U.S. Army Corps of Engineers reserves the right to modify/cancel reservations based on need for site closures. Examples: maintenance issues, storm damage, etc.		Engaging in or soliciting commercial or business activity is prohibited on government premises.
