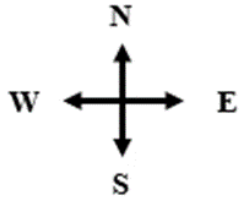

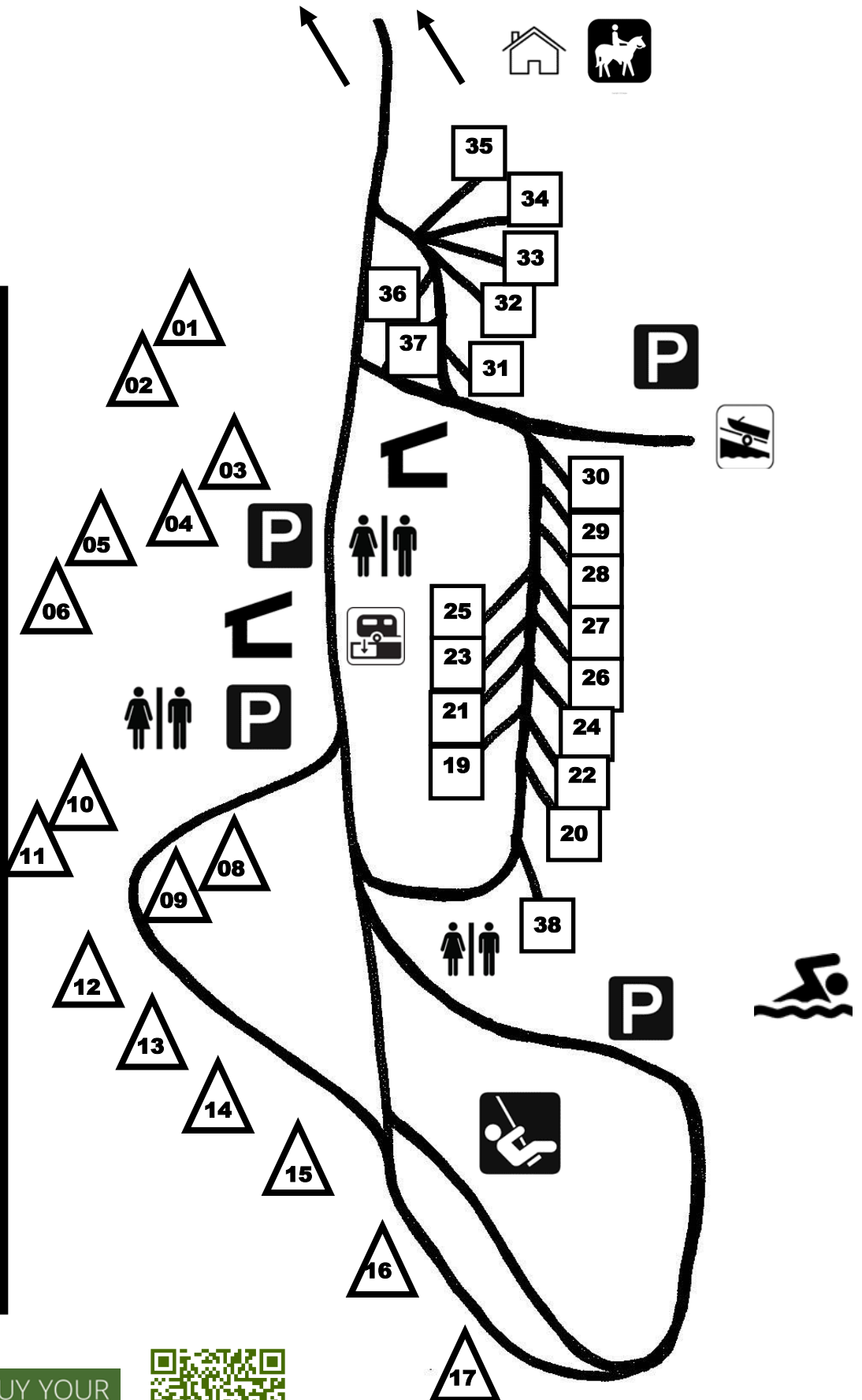

FEES

Camping— \$25/night Seasonal Camping (WINTER ONLY) - \$22/night Primitive—\$15/night
Boat Ramp— \$5/day Swimming— \$5/day Trail Riding— \$5/day Fishing—Free
Group Shelter (Electric)— \$50/day Group Shelter (Non-Electric) - \$25/day

THIS INFORMATION ENABLES ALL CAMPERS TO HAVE A GOOD STAY AT SHEPPARD POINT

1. **RESERVATIONS:** This campground is a cash-less facility during the off-season. All guest with camping reservations and Activity Passes must provide a confirmation ID when requested.
2. **AMENITIES:** Each site will have availability to water hookups and 30/50-amp electric at this park. Please see map for primitive tent sites that do not offer water and electrical service. Water is turned off during the off-season and restrooms are closed. Vault restrooms do not have running water or electric.
3. **QUIET HOURS:** Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM – 6:00 AM. Radios, generators, or other noise producing equipment may not be operated during these hours. Entrance gates close at 10:00 PM and opens at 6:00 AM each day. Exit gates remain open for emergency purposes.
4. **CAMPING CAPACITY:** Each site is allowed 1 camper and up to 2 tents or a total of 3 tents. Max number of vehicles per site is 2. Max number of people per site is 8. Vehicles need to always have at least 2 tires on pavement.
5. **PICNICKING:** Do not picnic on reservable sites. There are designated areas for picnicking along the swim beach area. Occupancy while on reserved site will be asked to move.
6. **PETS:** All pets must be on a leash at all times.
7. **GRILLS AND FIRE RINGS:** These are available at each campsite. Fires are permitted only in these containers. Dead wood may be gathered from the ground, but tree cutting is not permitted. Do not remove any wood from the campground. Do not leave trash or debris in the fire rings or grills. Remember to leave your campsite clean so others can enjoy camping in a clean site.
8. **EMERGENCIES:** Dial 911 for all medical emergencies. Please inform Park Ranger of situations as they occur.

Failure to follow rules may be subject for citation or removal off park grounds.
