CAMPING RULES

- Camping limit is 14 nights within a 30-day period.
- Pets must not be left unattended and must be caged or kept on a leash no longer than six feet. Please keep pets quiet.
- Camping units/personal property are not to be left unattended for more than 24 hours. Sites must be occupied nightly.
- Vehicles are permitted on designated roads only - please do not drive or park vehicles on the grass.
- Please be aware of all current fire restrictions.
- Check-out time is 2:00 p.m.
- Quiet hours are between 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- Only the collection of dead wood is allowed.
- See Title 36 on information boards for additional rules and regulations.

REMINDERS

- All boat ramp are for loading and unloading ONLY, no mooring.
- The dock platform is NOT a mooring dock or refueling station.
- NO cliff or rock jumping.
- While boating, abide by the red restricted area signs on either side of the dam.
- NO boats allowed upstream past the David Thompson Bridge.
- Please review Montana Fish, Wildlife, and Parks special fishing regulations for downstream of the dam.
- Don't forget to "Clean, Drain, and Dry" watercraft.
- ALWAYS wear your life jacket when you are in, on, or near water.
