

Curtis Creek Campground

Curtis Creek Campground is nestled in the mountains at the base of the Blue Ridge just minutes from the quaint town of Old Fort and less than an hour from the popular city of Asheville. Located on the first tract of National Forest land in the eastern US at the site of an old Civilian Conservation Corp (CCC) camp, the campground is surrounded by old growth forests and roaring trout streams.

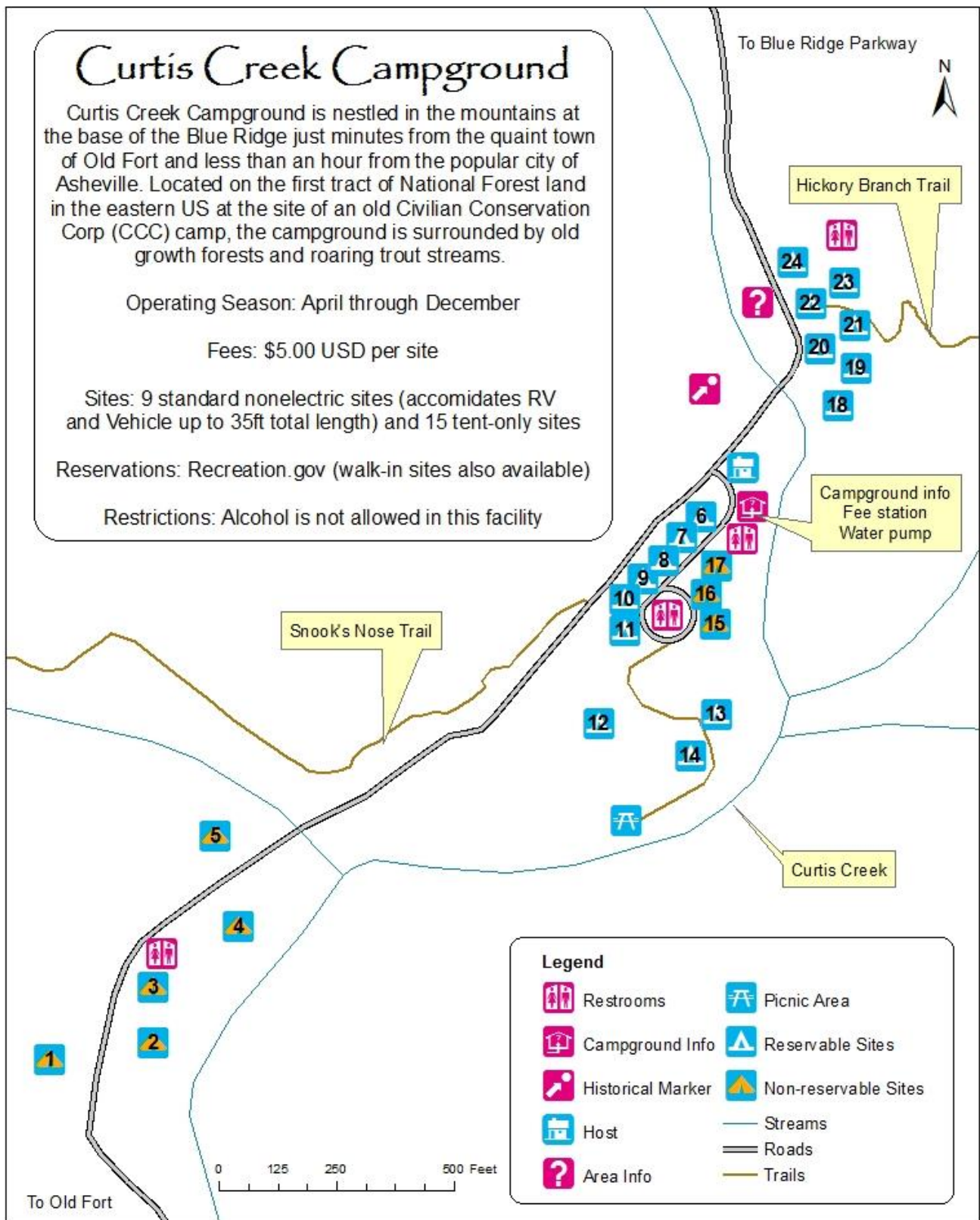
Operating Season: April through December

Fees: \$5.00 USD per site

Sites: 9 standard nonelectric sites (accommodates RV and Vehicle up to 35ft total length) and 15 tent-only sites

Reservations: Recreation.gov (walk-in sites also available)

Restrictions: Alcohol is not allowed in this facility
