Ragland Bottom Campground Rules and Regulations

Public use at all Corps of Engineers projects is governed by the Rules and Regulations set forth by the Secretary of the Army to provide visitors with safe recreational opportunities while protecting and enhancing natural resources. Title 36 Regulations apply on Center Hill Lake and can be found at the attendant's booth or on bulletin boards in the park.

- 1. Campsite Reservations:** Reservations for specific sites are recommended and be made through the National Recreation Reservation Service (NRRS) toll free at 1-877-444-6777 or at www.recreation.gov. Reservations are accepted up to six months in advance.
- 2. Camping Limit:** Camping is limited to 14 days in a 30 consecutive day period.
- 3. Walk-Up Sites:** We no longer have walk-up only sites. Any site can be booked at any time.
- 4. Site Limits:** Each site is limited to six people and two vehicles. A standard campsite may have one wheeled camping unit plus one tent; or two tents. All vehicles and camping equipment must fit on the designated site pad.
- 5. Parking:** All parking must be in designated parking places. Parking on the grass is prohibited.
- 6. Check In/Check Out:** Check In is at 3:30 PM; Check out is 2:30 PM Central Standard Time. Please depart your site promptly to provide for incoming campers. If you desire to stay beyond check out, please coordinate with the park attendant for a temporary location to park your equipment.
- 7. Visitors to Campers:** Permits are required for visitors to registered campers. The visitor fee is \$3.00 per vehicle or \$1.00 per person walking-in. Visitors must leave the park by 10:00 PM.
- 8. Quiet Hours:** Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM. Unreasonably loud noise is prohibited at any time and violators may be asked to vacate the campground.
- 9. Firewood:** Firewood that is not certified heat-treated is prohibited.
- 10. Fires:** Fires are only allowed in provided fire rings or grills. Do not leave fires unattended and extinguish all fires upon departure. Only dead wood on the ground may be collected for firewood. Garbage and other debris may not be placed in or burned in the fire rings or grills. Nailing, chopping, or cutting of trees is prohibited.
- 11. Sanitation:** Garbage must be disposed of in the provided dumpsters. Campsites must be clean upon your departure. No grey water (dishwater, outdoor showers, etc.) should be released on site; please use the dump stations in the campground for grey water disposal.
- 12. Pets:** Domestic pets (cats/dogs) are permitted. All pets must be penned, caged, or on a leash no longer than six feet. No pets are allowed in the restrooms, playgrounds, or the beach areas. All pet waste must be disposed of in the dumpsters. Do not leave your pet unattended.
- 13. Discounts:** Holders of the Interagency Senior Pass or Access Pass will receive a 50% discount on camping fees. The pass holder is the only individual authorized to use the pass when registering and paying fees and must be staying on site. Using one pass to reserve multiple campsites is prohibited.
- 14. Emergencies:** Report any emergencies, issues, or complaints to the park attendant. For life threatening emergencies, please call 911, then have someone notify the park attendant.
- 15. Other Prohibited Items:** Alcohol, firearms, fireworks, or weapons of any kind. ATVs, golf carts, and motorized scooters are also not allowed; Only licensed, street legal motorized vehicles can operate inside the campground.
- 16. Loud, rowdy or other inappropriate behavior will result in your removal from the campground without benefit of refund.**
